### CHILDHOOD

- -BORN IN LOG CABIN. FATHER DIES BEFORE HE IS BORN. RAISED BY HIS MOTHER IN POVERTY. LOVED SPORTS MORE THAN SCHOOL WORK.
- -AMERICAN REVOLUTION ENDS HIS CHILDHOOD, AGE OF 13, HE JOINS LOCAL MILITIA. CAPTURED BY THE BRITISH. NEARLY DIES OF SMALL POX IN BRITISH PRISON.
- -QUICK TEMPER- WOULD PICK A FIGHT AT THE DROP OF A HAT, AND "AS ONE FRIEND RECALLED "HE WOULD USUALLY DROP THE HAT."

### POST REVOLUTIONARY WAR

-Decides to become a lawyer. Buy's slaves, and plantation. Moves to Nashville Tennessee. Serves in House and Senate.



- -MARRIES RACHEL DONELSON/ CAPTAIN LEWIS ROBARDS.
  CONTROVERSY
- -Never out grows his temper. Duel with Charles Dickinson. Lives with bullet near his heart till his Death.
- -ENGAGES IN MANY DUELS, FIGHTS, BRAWLS. NEVER WOULD BACK DOWN FROM A FIGHT.
- -WAR OF 1812 " OLD HICKORY". EARNS FAME.

### **RUN FOR PRESIDENCY**


- -ELECTION OF 1824- WINS ELECTORAL VOTES BUT NOT MAJORITY. PROMISED REVENGE!
- -DEMOCRATIC PARTY- REPRESENTED ORDINARY
  FARMERS, WORKERS, POOR, NOT THE RICH AND WELL
  BORN WHO HAD TAKEN CONTROL OF THE REPUBLICANS.
  ORGANIZED HUGE PARADES, SLOGANS, WORE BADGES,
  CHANTED CATCHY SLOGAN, "ADAMS CAN WRITE,
  JACKSON CAN FIGHT!
- -WINS THE ELECTION OF 1828- START OF "JACKSONIAN DEMOCRACY".


